

Hosting an Event or Birthday Party with us?

Here's what **NOT** to Bring to Cal Skate/FunLand:

Our 'Classic' and 'V.I.P.' Birthday Party offer very limited clean-up time for us to get the area(s) back to acceptable standards for the next party, session, or group arriving after your time is up. Plus, we need to have our skating areas (carpet and the skating floor) clear of tripping or sticking materials that could easily be a hazard for skaters. We've been doing parties for almost 50 years now and our party experts have come up with an experienced list of items that either pose a risk for accidents, or could involve exhaustive, timely, and expensive cleanup. The following items are not permitted inside for the above reasons, as well as some suggestions, to avoid expensive add-on cleaning or repair fees:

Prohibited Item Examples:

- Outside food and drinks (unless approved by a manager for a V.I.P. or private party only)
- Confetti or confetti-filled balloons
- 'Slime' toys/gifts or treat bag items
- 'Silly String' is definitely not allowed on the premises – inside or outside!
- Face Painters - unless their services and application style are pre-approved by management
- Alcoholic beverages (unless specifically permitted by management, in very rare situations)
- Chewing gum or gummies (i.e. 'fruit snacks', jelly beans, taffy, gummy candy, Tootsie rolls, etc.)
- Candy that could pose a choking hazard if a skater falls (Lollipops, suckers, candy canes, etc.)
- 'Candy Tables' with buffet-style, loose, candy (Skittles, M&M's, etc.), NO chocolate fountains!
- Pets (except trained service animals – 'ESA/Emotional Support Animals' are **NOT** ADA recognized)
- Table decorations that include small/hard 'decorative' pieces (candy, beads, confetti, stones, etc.)
- Nails, screws, or duct tape to hang decorations – ceiling and wall banners need to be cleared first
- Smoking or reeking of smoke (especially pot) that lingers into the next party's rental time
- Food fights or face 'cake smashing' – carpet and bathroom cleaning fees could be applied
- Personal skates, 'Razor-style' scooters, or ride-on street toys need to be inspected & approved
- Permanent or felt markers left for young guests to color/decorate with
- Popsicles or ice cream bars – usually these are left unattended to melt and cause messes/stains
- Ice Cream sundae self-serve 'build-your-own' ice cream tables – same for taco/nacho tables!

Additional Reminders:

- Be aware - **excessive decorations require more clean-up time** – your paid party time will be cut short to perform these clean-up duties (you can **not** have added time to perform these tasks)
- Clean-up or repair fees could be added at management's discretion – minimum \$250 fee.
- Table decorations need to be saved until your 'Classic Party' room time (not at the snack bar table)
- Our goal is not to negate your party ideas, or to limit your fun. Just like the party before yours, we want to make sure your area is suitable for your event and that your guests are safe, as with the guests skating after your party. Call **BEFORE** your party day if you are unsure or have questions.
